With these 13 nights 14 days All Nepal round tour package is one of the best options to explore major cities in Nepal such as Kathmandu, Nagarkot, Dhulikhel, Pokhara, Tansen, Lumbini, and Chitwan. It is an excellent chance to explore the diverse nature and culture in a short time. Visiting 7 UNESCO World Heritage sites and historical palaces in Tansen will give you a better insight into Nepal's history and culture.

Your trip begins in Kathmandu by exploring the Pashupatinath Temple, Bouddhanath Stupa, Swyambhunath Stupa, Patan Durbar Square, and Kathmandu Durbar Square. These places have their unique architecture and have historical and religious significance. When you come to Lake City Pokhara, enjoy many fun activities like boating, paragliding, visiting temples, caves, etc. Tansen offers you the historical palaces and allows you to explore the ancient Newari culture. Lumbini, the birthplace of Gautama Buddha, is a great place to study Buddhism and architecture from different countries in monasteries. Chitwan jungle safari is the best option to explore wildlife and birds. It offers you more species of flora and fauna than in any other region of Nepal.

On this tour, we will provide you a private vehicle from one city to another and enjoy the fantastic view of landscapes, lush forests, and mountains. As a big city, many people from all over Nepal move here. Therefore, visiting these cities is like exploring the whole country, since they have preserved and celebrated their culture in these cities. You can participate in various jatras and festivals celebrated by different ethnic groups.

Therefore, the tour of Kathmandu, Nagarkot, Pokhara, Tansen, Lumbini, and Chitwan is ideal for those who want to explore Nepal's diversity in a short time without losing comfort.

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

When you arrive at Kathmandu International Airport, our representatives will pick you up on board with your name on. Then it will take you to a three-star hotel. You will relax in the hotel for a while; you can tour nearby places if you want. You can buy the personal items you need during the tour if you haven't already. A brief tour informational takes place in the evening.

Day 02: - Full day excursion of the Kathmandu valley and drive to Nagarkot

Today early morning, after breakfast, take a full-day sightseeing tour of the Kathmandu Valley. You will visit the sacred Temple of Pashupatinath and Swyambhunath, which are very old and largely UNESCO World Heritage Site. Boudhanath's largest Buddhist stupa and the fine arts and historical architecture of Kathmandu's Durbar Square, reflecting ancient Nepalese culture, are the main attraction on your tour. After visiting these places, there is an hour and 40 minutes' drive from Nagarkot, 2175m above sea level, a beautiful home that offers an excellent sunrise and sunset view over the Himalayas. On bright days you can also see Mount Everest. The terraced fields on the sloping hills, the green hills, and the river valleys' look are excellent!

Day 03: - Drive Nagarkot to Dhulikhel

In the early morning, enjoy sunrise and mountain views. You can see the superb view of the Nepalese Himalayas' significant peaks, including Mount Everest, Manaslu, Ganesh Himal, Langtang, Gaurishanker, and number from Nagarkot. Then you will have breakfast and head to Dhulikhel: the next destination, about an hour and a half drive, takes you to Dhulikhel, check-in at the hotel, you can look around the city of Dhulikhel.

Day 04: - Dhulikhel to Bhaktapur and Changu Narayan and back to Kathmandu

After breakfast, you have a short drive to visit the ancient and historical city of Bhaktapur. After Bhaktapur, you see the Changu Narayan Temple, dedicated to Lord Vishnu, and It was built in the 4th century and had a stone inscription called

Nepal's first recorded history. It is one of the UNESCO recognized cultural heritage sites in Nepal then drives to the Kathmandu hotel. You will spend a night at three star deluxe hotel in Kathmandu.

Day 05: Everest Mountain Flight and journey to Pokhara

Mount Everest Mountain Flight is a widespread tourist activity in the Nepalese Himalayas. Today morning, you will do a one-hour Everest mountain flight over Mount Everest to get the Himalayas' best views. This flight will take you to Mount Everest and the surrounding mountains within an hour of boarding the plane. You can see the maximum highest peaks, including Mount Everest, and then return to the hotel.

After breakfast, drive to Pokhara. During this 6-hour trip, you will enjoy the panoramic view of landscapes, valleys, forests, etc. Most of the time, you will drive along the Trishuli River. When you arrive in Pokhara, check into a hotel and cool off. In the evening, explore the city streets, shop for souvenirs, and explore restaurants, cafes, lounges, bars, etc. The roads of Pokhara are vibrant and lively for strolling at night.

Day 06: Trek to Sarangkot (1590m)

From Pokhara, you take a walk to Sarangkot early in the morning. The hike to the top of Sarangkot gives us a great view of the high hills and a beautiful view of the beautiful surroundings, including the green forest, cultural regions, local settlements, gorgeous lakes, and other things. You will stay at a local hotel there.

Day 07: - Paragliding and a full-day tour of the city of Pokhara

Today, you will have paragliding. You will get up early in the morning to enjoy the magnificent view of the sun that rises from the east and penetrates the white snow and the Giants' mountains. Then you will wait until you have the paragliding in Sarangkot. Paragliding takes you to the Pokhara Valley near Phewa Lake. After the paragliding, you can visit the different places where you can enjoy the Pokhara Valley's true beauty. After lunch, visit the famous David Fall, Mahendra

Cave, Tibetan refugee camp, and the Ancient Museum. In the evening, there is a boat ride on Lake Phewa, where you can enjoy the spectacular view of the Annapurna Himalaya mountain range, which is reflected in its entire splendor in the calm green waters of the lake visit the Bindavasini temple in the middle from the lake.

Day 8: Drive Pokhara to Tansen

After breakfast, drive to Tansen. On this nearly 5-hour bus ride, take in the scenery with beautiful scenery, rivers, and forested valleys. On the way to Tansen, you will pass through many picturesque villages. When you arrive in Tansen, check into a hotel and head out to explore Tansen's city. This city is strongly influenced by Newari culture and is famous for producing beautiful woven fabrics. The Nepal National Caps (Dhaka Topi) are made here in the old weaving center. When you visit the city, you get a better insight into the people's culture and traditions.

Day 9: full-day excursion to Palpa Tansen and trip to Lumbini

You will wake up early morning and walk to Srinagar Hill to experience the fascinating sunrise view. The surrounding landscapes, rivers, and jungle look fantastic from the top of the Shreenagar. After enjoying the view, return to the hotel and have breakfast. On this day you will make a day trip through the city of Tansen. Tansen's picturesque city has two important historical sites, namely Tansen Durbar and Rani Mahal The Tansen king Palace was built in 1927 by Pratap Shamsher Jang Bahadur Rana. Now it has become the museum that preserves the history and culture of the place. Rani Mahal is famous as the Taj Mahal from Nepal. This incredible palace is located on the banks of the Kali Gandaki River. In this palace, some kings ruled the Tansen before the unification of Nepal. In addition to these two palaces, you can explore the city. Newari culture influences the architecture of most buildings in this region. You can buy souvenirs and crafts from local people and then drive to Lumbini. After about 3-4 hours by car, you will arrive in Lumbini.

Day 10: a full-day tour of Lumbini

On this day of your trip, you will take a day trip to Lumbini. Lumbini is a birthplace of Lord Buddha and one of the UNESCO World Heritage sites in Nepal. Starting from the Ashokan column, visit the Lumbini Museum. You will see the Mayadevi Temple, the most famous place in Lumbini. You will see several monasteries built in the style of different countries such as China, Korea, Vietnam, Thailand, etc. All the places in the climb have cultural and historical importance. You will explore all these places with the help of a guide who will give you all the region information. After a full-day excursion to Lumbini, return to your hotel and rest.

Day 11: Tilaurakot sightseeing and driving to Chitwan

After breakfast in Lumbini, you visit Tilaurakot to see the sights. It is the home of Siddhartha, a holy place for all Buddhists. From Tilaurakot drive to Chitwan. You will cross many towns, cities, and dense jungles along the Mahendra Highway to reach Chitwan. After approximately four hours of driving, you check into a hotel in Chitwan and take a break. Later in the evening, explore the beautiful village of Tharu people. Tharu indigenous communities have their own culture, tradition, and lifestyle. You walk through beautiful rice fields and jungles and also enjoy the beautiful sunset.

Day 12: Safari excursion through the jungle of the Chitwan National Park

Today will take breakfast early in the morning and start a nature tour of the Chitwan National Park. This day will be full of many adventure activities like canoeing, elephant rides, jungle safari, etc. You will wander through the jungle to explore the floras and fauna. You will be guided by an experienced professional nature guide who has a deep understanding of its flora and fauna. You will have an elephant ride to walk through the jungle. From the elephant's back, you have a chance to get some ideas about animals like one-horn rhino, Bengal tigers, gharial, etc. Then you can canoe down the Rapti River. Spend the day in the park's peaceful surroundings and enjoy the traditional stick dance of the Tharu community after dinner at the hotel.

Day 13: Drive from Chitwan to Kathmandu

After breakfast early in the morning, you can go for bird watching in the Chitwan National Park. This park is home to 840 different birds species, more than any other protected region in Nepal. After bird watching, drive to Kathmandu. It takes 5-6 hours to reach Kathmandu from Chitwan. On the way, you will pass through dense forests, river valleys, many picturesque towns, and suburbs. You check into a Three-star hotel and take a rest. In the evening, you can stroll the Thamel streets and shop for souvenirs and crafts.

Day 14: - Final departure

According to your flight departure time, we will take you to the international airport to take the flight back to your home. With the hopping to see you in the coming days.

Accommodation and food

All accommodation for the All Nepal Round Tour is included in the double room, including travel costs. They are selected according to the hygiene standard, the service standard, and the catering standard, the location, etc. You will spend three-star hotel accommodations in Kathmandu, Nagarkot, Dhulikhel, Pokhara, Tansen, and Lumbini in bed and breakfast plan and two nights in Chitwan National Park with full board (room, breakfast, lunch, and dinner). We provide buffet breakfast at the hotel. If you are traveling alone, share a place with another person of the same gender as your group. If you prefer a single room, you must inform before booking the tour and receive individual rooms on request, paying an available room surcharge

Visa Requirements

All Nepal visitors need a visa to enter Nepal. You can get it at a Nepalese embassy abroad or upon arrival in Nepal. Most people obtain their visas upon arrival at Kathmandu airport.

You will have a passport size photo and the following fees depending:

v 15 days USD \$ 25 or an equivalent convertible currency

v 30 days USD \$ 40 or an equivalent convertible currency

v 90 days USD 100 or equivalent convertible currency

Cultural consideration

For those of you visiting Nepal, we provided cultural information to help you adjust and feel good:

The dress code is essential for both men and women. Men and women should wear pants instead of shorts during a tour in Kathmandu. It's fine for men in vests, but Women should try to be as modest as possible in these situations.

Hindus are concerned about ritual contamination of food when someone outside their caste or religion touches it. Therefore, do not feel any cooked food on

display. When playing from a container used by others, do not touch your lips. Don't eat with your left hand, and be sure to eat or receive only your right hand. The shoes are considered degrading. So keep them on the floor and take them out before you put your feet on anything. When entering a Nepal house, follow the example of your host to decide if you need to take off your shoes. However, when you enter a temple or monastery, you must remove them.

You will pass Buddhist walls, Chorten, and Buddhist stupas along the way, and follow local traditions and place them on your right.

Travel insurance

Travel insurance for each itinerary of our company is a prerequisite for booking vacations. At a minimum, you must have emergency and repatriation insurance that must include the cost of mountain rescue, theft, loss, damage, and clinical problems. It is a brilliant idea to travel in Nepal. There are a variety of guidelines. Please read your insurers' general terms and conditions carefully, especially in the vital part, which is written in small letter. Some policies exclude "dangerous activities," including motorcycling and trekking, bungee jumping, and rafting.

Select a policy covering clinical return and emergency return, including walking helicopter evacuation and general medical evacuation. Maybe, You prefer a policy that pays hospitals directly rather than issuing it on-site and claiming it later. Gives them locally and claim them later. In Nepal, most clinical treatments must be paid for at delivery. If your insurance company doesn't make an advance payment, make sure you receive the payment receipts to claim them later.

It would help if you could understand that you would bear the cost of the evacuation and return procedures. You must pay for it: evacuation or medical treatment. You must be fully aware of travel insurance's effects and understand the limitations and exclusions of your policy. Please note that in certain circumstances, our company guide can initiate helicopter rescue operations (or other necessary operations) in medical emergencies without first seeking approval from your insurance company.
